

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Like what?

McKEAG JOHNS: And I — Well, honestly it's because you're pushing so hard. I mean, you've pushed Steve Rambo. You've pushed Rusty. So we've both said things that we probably shouldn't have and — I'm trying to help you (inaudible).

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Uh-huh.

McKEAG JOHNS: And – and it's coming back to bite both of us. I'm not going to lie.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Well, I'm not trying to bite you in any way, shape or form. Or Rusty. All I was doing was calling to ask Rusty – Rusty – so are those charges

going to be dropped. Well, now, apparently, because Jersey got on the stand and said that had nothing to do with Cory Franklin, now there's an investigation on tampering with a witness. Trying to fuckin' say that Cory told him to say that or something. Which is fucking absolute shit.

McKEAG JOHNS: I think that you did great work and I will pass that along all day long. I've been honest with you in the beginning to the end, and I've been consistent about it.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Yeah.

McKEAG JOHNS: Look, I can help you. I will attempt to help Cory, but I've got no promises. Is that not what I've said?

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Yeah.

McKEAG JOHNS: I've said that a hundred fuckin' times to you. Right?

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Yeah.

McKEAG JOHNS: Okay. And I will continue to do that. But people like Tim Baldwin with their agendas, in my opinion, are only going to hurt you.

Or not especially fess up to, but he needs - (beeps) needs to deal with some things. He has some things that are definitely he needs to deal with.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Yeah.

McKEAG JOHNS: And - and you guys need to figure that out.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Yeah, he just sat there and talked about how these vehicles that I owned have all these guns in them and drugs in them. And there's - one of them was stolen, and these all belong to Kristina Franklin and - this just got done vesterday.

McKEAG JOHNS: What I know of you that's stolen, is that one gun. You had it you and Cory, in some fashion, and I don't know what the truth is. (Beep.) And that was another thing that I meant to bring up to you on Monday when I talked to you, is that we need to get you in and get a recorded statement from you as to those guns.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Okay. (Beep.)

McKEAG JOHNS: 'Cause that may - that may turn it to where they don't come back on you at all. I don't know. But I've told you all along we need to get you in and get you a recorded state -

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Okay. Hey - Oh, he hung up again -

McKEAG JOHNS: — where those guns came from. That's the only thing that I know of that Kristina Franklin owns that — that's stolen, is that one gun.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Yeah.

McKEAG JOHNS: Five guns that day. And – and I know that you guys have some guns that you keep at your mother's house or grandpa's house, or whatever, that don't necessarily belong to Cory, but - you guys – hah, you know.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Yeah.

McKEAG JOHNS: And when Cory is seen with a gun, he's on probation.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: I know but they weren't even his. Like the first time, I was out shooting that day with Shandy, and that's the only reason that gun was in the truck. He hopped in my fuckin' truck to take Alan.

McKEAG JOHNS: Yeah. But that's normally Cory's truck, and that's – I mean, Cory is seen in that truck; that's Cory's work truck; and you – you know what I mean? When Cory can't have guns, Kristina shouldn't have guns and – in – in faith of her husband.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Yeah, I know. But that's never been the law.

McKEAG JOHNS: Well, no, it's not exactly the law as written. But, gee, you got to watch out for that stuff, you know.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: I know.

McKEAG JOHNS: I know you love Cory, I know that.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Yeah.

McKEAG JOHNS: Okay?

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Uh-huh.

McKEAG JOHNS: That's obvious.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: (Crying.)

McKEAG JOHNS: It's a matter of making the right decisions, Kristina. And they're -- they're in so many ways; they're a matter of keeping the guns away, not owning

them. It's a matter of not dealing methamphetamine. It's a matter of potentially choosing the right attorney. It's a matter – there's just a lot of steps here.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: I know.

McKEAG JOHNS: And I would help you more if I could but this is what I see,
I'm passing along to more to you than I should.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Uh-huh.

McKEAG JOHNS: Honestly.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Yeah.

McKEAG JOHNS: You have three kids – you have three kids that need – need and deserve to grow up in the right fashion. Are you still clean?

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Yeah.

McKEAG JOHNS: That's awesome. I mean, that's my number one goal with the job that I do.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Yeah, but -

McKEAG JOHNS: Is that you're --

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: - it doesn't even seem worth it. It's like my husband's still not home.

McKEAG JOHNS: - because at the end of the day, it's your kids.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: (Crying.) I know. But my kids need their dad.

McKEAG JOHNS: Yeah. And their dad – and their mom don't need to be addicted to methamphetamine.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: I know you're right, but he's not. He swears he'll never do it again and I believe him because he's never, ever said that he'll never do it again.

McKEAG JOHNS: All I'm saying is, you got to look – you got to look at this stuff -- I know it's different for you. I know that, I know that you can say, "God, that gun belongs to me, I frickin' left it wherever." How is the jury going to look at it?

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: I don't know.

McKEAG JOHNS: How is the jury going to see that when it's presented to them?

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: I don't know.

McKEAG JOHNS: Cory drove that Durango that day to that hotel.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Uh-huh.

McKEAG JOHNS: Whether he got it five minutes before, five hours, five days, five weeks, it doesn't matter. He drove it there with five fuckin' guns in it.

Every other attorney out there typically kind of works with us or we work with them, we try to find a deal that works good for you guys.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Yeah.

McKEAG JOHNS: You know. There was a deal that was offered, I think it was a good deal. Personally. For what Cory is looking against, I think it was a good deal.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Yeah.

McKEAG JOHNS: I-I-But that's me.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: I just – I – I can't say it enough, uh-ha, and I know that you guys hear it all the time, and it's so whatever. But he's not fucking guilty. Both times you've given the motherfucker a ride, and both times he got fucked. It's like this is so sickening because he's didn't fucking do it. (Crying.)

McKEAG JOHNS: So let's – let's look at it – let's look at it totally different.

You and me. Essentially different. Let's say Kristina's a drug dealer, okay.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Yeah.

McKEAG JOHNS: Kristina's a meth dealer. And honestly, maybe that's true, I don't know. You know, Kristina's a meth dealer and he got caught giving people rides. It doesn't matter, Kristina. He's on probation. He got put into a position where he gave – said meth dealers a ride. Okay?

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: So that's a revocation of his probation, great.

McKEAG JOHNS: It is. It is a revocation --

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: That's fine.

McKEAG JOHNS: -- against his probation.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: But all these other charges, is what's pissing me off. Is he wasn't dealing drugs, he didn't have possession with intent to sell. And he never, ever – never, ever have they found drugs on him. (Overtalking.)

McKEAG JOHNS: (Inaudible) possession. But I didn't - I can't recall honestly.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: No, he still has six charges pending.

McKEAG JOHNS: All I'm saying is, it's what you can prove, okay?

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Yeah.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Uh-huh.

McKEAG JOHNS: You know, if you'll look at it: even if Kristina, the wife, is the dealer and Cory's giving a ride to a felon, to somebody dealing methamphetamine to –

McKEAG JOHNS: - somebody in possession of stolen firearms, those are all those are all charges against his probation. They're all revocations against his probation.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Which is fine. And I'm not – That's not what I'm so pissed about. It's like revoking probation, whatever, do what the fuck you're going to do. But all these other charges are what I'm so fuckin' worried about because if they stick, he is going to be an innocent man sitting in fuckin' prison, wasting his entire life away because Rusty wants to prove a fuckin' point. And it's like he doesn't even care if he's guilty or innocent, he just wants a guilty verdict. (Crying.)

McKEAG JOHNS: No, he does.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: No, he doesn't. He just wants a guilty verdict.

McKEAG JOHNS: No, he does.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Bullshit.

McKEAG JOHNS: Honestly, he does.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Then why aren't they dropped yet? Why aren't those charges in the motel room dropped yet, when he knows – when Jersey even said that he wasn't guilty – (overtalking). Instead, he just wants to be like, oh, Cory must have told him to do that and now he's fuckin' pursuing that.

McKEAG JOHNS: Is it any different that Rusty has bigger issues towards Tim Baldwin or Tim Baldwin is taking advantage of Cory and Kristina Franklin? (Beep.) Is it any different?

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: I have no idea. No, I guess not. But it's not right because it's affecting our lives.

McKEAG JOHNS: Well, look -

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: It's not affecting either of theirs.

McKEAG JOHNS: Hey! The County Attorney's Office could say, Look, Rusty's got too much personal involvement in this case, we're going to give it to somebody else.

And I guarantee you that they would because the County Attorney himself is a political position, and if that political position about itself was in danger that it would adjust itself, but it feels so strongly about what's going on -- and about Tim Baldwin that it's hanging on to what it's got. Okay?

McKEAG JOHNS: Okay?

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Okay.

McKEAG JOHNS: Rusty's told it to you. I have in the past have told it to you, thinking that I was doing the right thing, but I'm not sure that I am now, so I can't say it anymore.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: All right.

McKEAG JOHNS: I think that you need to just look at the progress that's going on, the results you're getting, and make your own adjustments, and (inaudible). That make sense?

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Yeah.

McKEAG JOHNS: Kristina, I'll help you.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: All right.

McKEAG JOHNS: Like I said, I would – I would beg, borrow and plead to have a CI as good as you, do as good a work as you have. I have passed along the work you've done. Okay?

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Uh-huh.

McKEAG JOHNS: Good God. Is there a freak show here? Um, sorry. To – to help you out, I would.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Yeah.

McKEAG JOHNS: I think that you have a problem. I think you have a problem with methamphetamine. I think that you've worked on it. I think that you're on the right steps, path. You've got people keeping you accountable to your kids. You've got a good job now. I think you're making the right steps, Kristina.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Yeah.

McKEAG JOHNS: But at the same time, you have a problem. You have an addiction. Okay?

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Yeah.

McKEAG JOHNS: You know. I mean, it is what it is, but for your kids, you need to live. Nickey Ferrari is a horrible fuckin' example.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Yeah.

McKEAG JOHNS: That bitch is the most self-destructive, evil mother I've ever seen in my entire life.

McKEAG JOHNS: I would take your kids into my house every day of the week.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: Uh-huh.

McKEAG JOHNS: Because it's all about the fuckin' kids.

KRISTINA FRANKLIN: No, I agree.

McKEAG JOHNS: I don't give a shit about Cory or Kristina Franklin, I don't give a shit about Hot Rod or Nickey Ferrari, or anybody else involved. I give a shit about the kids.

McKEAG JOHNS: That's personally how I feel.


